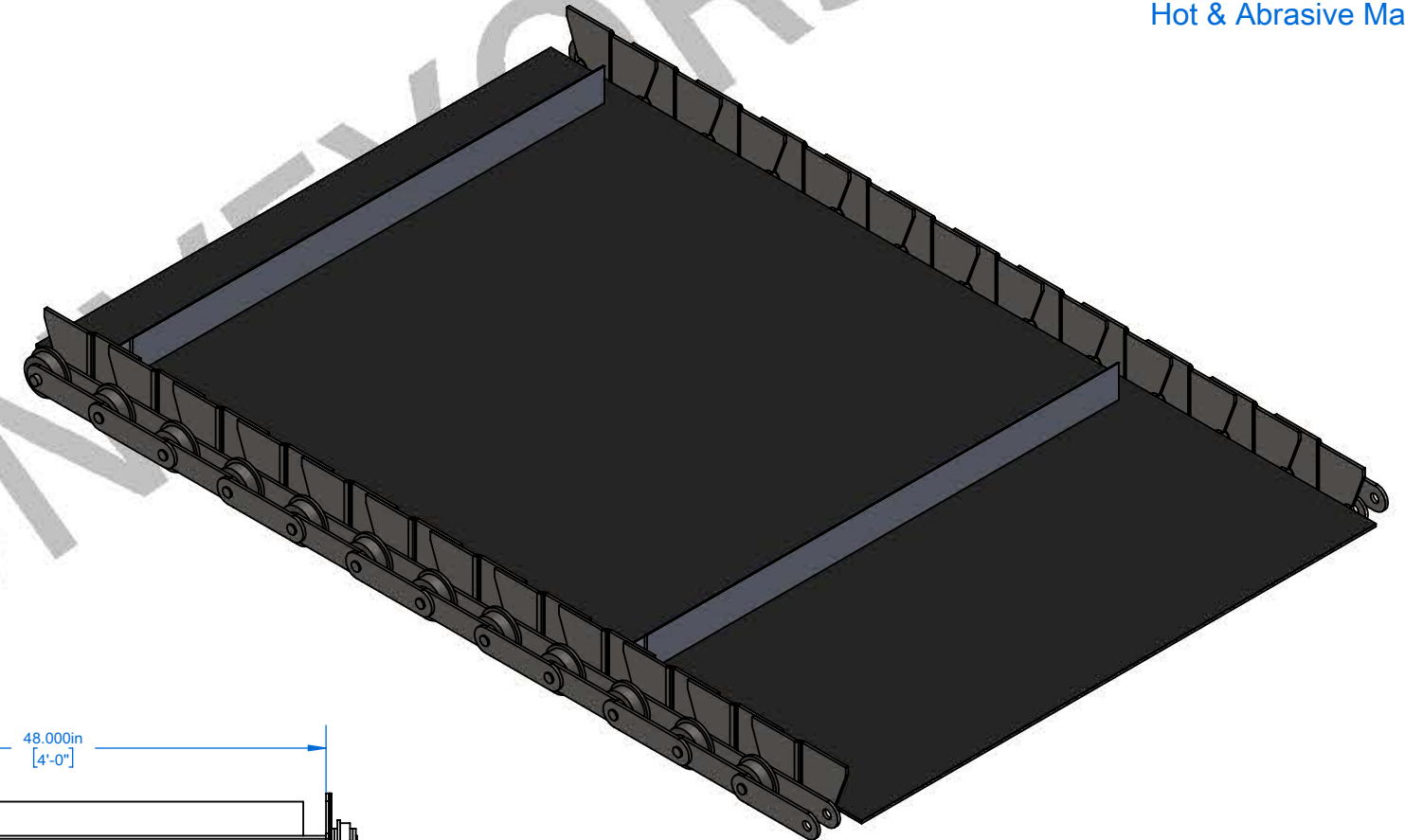
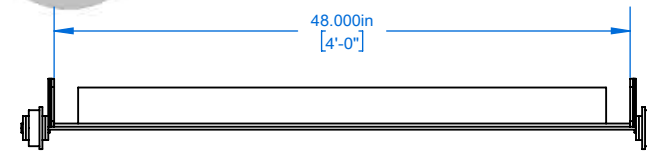
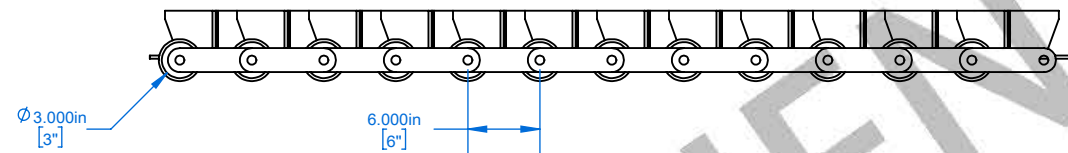
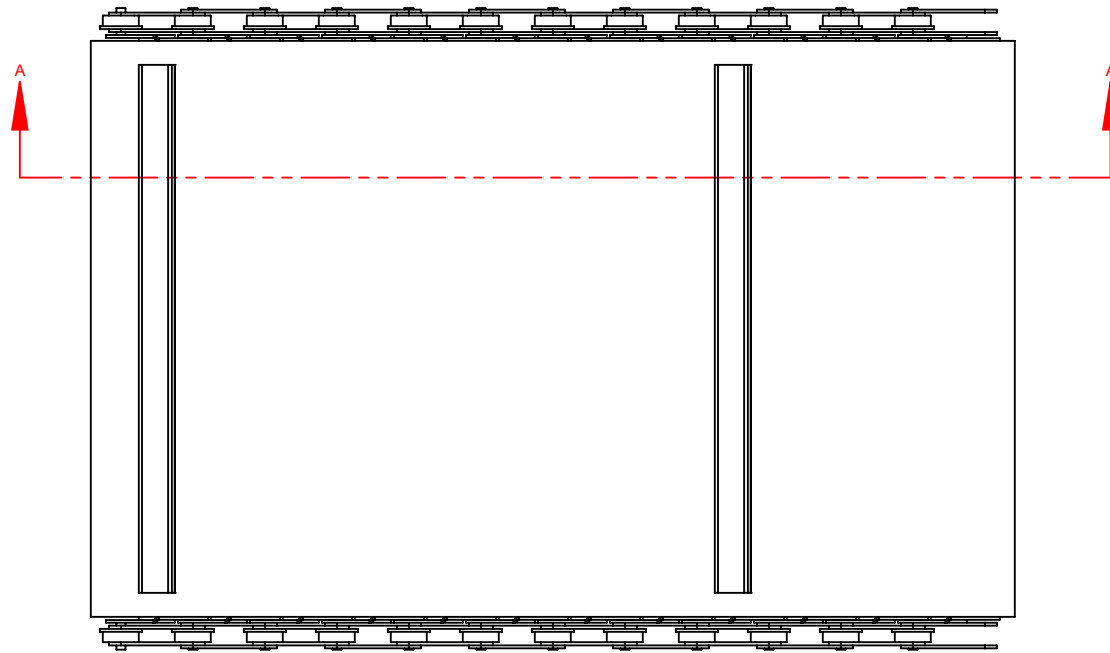


48" Rubber & PVC Combination Conveyor Belts

Fluent Rubber & PVC Combination Conveyor Belts are the most commonly used conveyor belts in the recycling industry. They typically have 3" or 4" cleats spaced anywhere between 24" -72" depending on the material stream. They can be used in single stream, MSW, bio-fuel, e-waste, OCC, paper, tissue paper, ONP, mixed plastics, rubber and more. These belts can be used in both wet and dry environments on horizontal and/or incline conveyors. The loading of this belt is not as strong as a steel belt but can withstand large loading amounts depending on the material type and drop distance. These conveyor belts can be made to order for customer widths not to exceed 108" for both rubber (1 ply, 2 ply, 3 ply, 4 ply) and PVC (PVC 100,200,300,400)

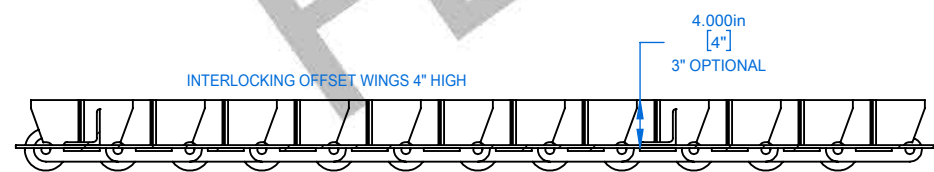
